

TURNING DREAMERS INTO CHANGEMAKERS

The Kautilya School of Public Policy has blazed a definitive path for public policy education in India.

The Class of 2023 was the first chapter in our mission to script change. The roles secured by the graduates across India's top companies, including Paytm, I-PAC, Bharat Biotech, Global Trade Observer, and RBI-H, are a testament to the visionary approach the Master's Program in Public Policy takes to shaping minds.

The 2-year MPP also prepared our students to envision and design solutions at the intersection of governance and policy. This is evidenced by the host of elite fellowships and partnerships our graduates secured. Our partners include the Niti Aayog, the Punjab Government, and the National Centre for Good Governance. Our students are also set to drive impact-focused research through elite think tanks such as CEEW and the Quality Control of India (QCI).

The founding principle of the 2-year MPP is to train students with a global outlook for designing solutions in the Indian context. Our unified methodology equips students with a multidisciplinary worldview. They learn diverse subjects such as Design Thinking, Econometrics, and Global Public Health.

On the other hand, we also empower students through extensive industry training. Skill shops such as Performance Measurement and Evaluation in Public and Non-Profit Sector, Media, Communications and Policy, Negotiation, Assessing Climate Risk prove valuable in fortifying a student's confidence and bringing them an in-depth understanding of the industry's needs. Each student can factor in these learnings to specialize in areas of their choice and excel from the get-go.

We hold engagement sessions with each student to strengthen employability, general awareness, and interview skills. These qualities are often the deciding factor during one-on-one interviews.

We complement these efforts by arranging internships for the students at India's premier institutes, including Ashok Leyland, JSW Steel, and Philip Morris International. For a deeper understanding of the complex dynamics of policy-based governance, we also arranged internships for students with the governments of Telangana, Delhi, Maharashtra, and Rajasthan, along with opportunities in Central government-run entities such as the QCI and the Data Security Council of India.

The aim is to ensure that this time exponentially enhances a student's industry perspective and shapes their vision for the future. Students work with these institutes and understand problem-solving at a granular level.

We are evolving with each batch and are confident of reshaping the landscape of public policy education in India.


